

Bexhill College: Coronavirus update for Students and Parents/Carers

Wednesday 25th March 2020

This is our latest update for students and parents/carers. It contains some information we have provided previously – where this has not changed along with new information where we have this.

Updates

Throughout this difficult period, we remain committed to providing a high-quality education service for our students. These are unprecedented times with exceptional challenges, which are impacting on our ability to provide our normal services. As such, we are putting arrangements in place for remote working that promote social distancing as advised by Government.

We will continue to update the website on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays** for the time being with any new information we have. This will be updated by 6.30pm on those days. Please be aware that we may not be able to fully respond to that day's Government announcements but we will do so, as appropriate, the following day or as soon as we reasonably can.

Following announcements about the closure of schools and colleges until further notice and the decision not to run exams this year, we are still waiting for information about what exactly this means. We understand students will get a grade for the qualifications they are studying based on teacher assessment but we do not know the detail of how that will be operated as yet. Therefore, the staff are continuing to provide remote learning. All students should continue to complete this, as the staff will use this as part of any teacher based assessment which we believe the exam boards will ask for this as part of their processes for awarding the qualifications.

For courses which are coursework based, such as the Extended Diplomas, Subsidiaries and the Certificates, we are anticipating that grading will be based on coursework grades so all student should be completing coursework as set.

We understand that Colleges will be provided with more details on how to do this from Ofqual by the end of this week. We will then update parents and students.

Services on site

The College site is now closed to students. The online learning process will operate as outlined below. Information for our students on EHCPs has also been circulated to those individual students.

Online Learning:

Since it became evident that the action to combat the Coronavirus might call for changes to everyday activities, our curriculum departments and technical teams have been working on preparing for whole college remote learning. Staff continue to work hard to develop and refine the content they provide online.

Subject staff will have been in regular communication with their students with regard to the systems and expectations for remote learning which will differ from course to course depending on the nature of the subject and available resources.

We continue to ask all our students to ensure they check the following on a daily basis:

- Student Email
- College Website
- MOODLE
- Any other communication media which their courses use

Online TA support has been allocated to those students who receive additional support already for their studies, to help facilitate their on-line learning.

Unless ill or unable to be available for other reasons, staff are following the usual timetabled periods and will be available on-line at usual lesson and tutorial times to respond to student queries. If staff are unable to respond during these times, students will be informed about alternative arrangements.

Online Student Services support remains available for students who need to information on financial or student welfare matters.

Reports

Parents will be aware that we were due to issue reports just before the Easter break. We are postponing issuing these until we fully understand how the grading for those courses with end of year exams/grades will be decided. We will provide further information in due course.
